Job Summary

This is an important position at a high-potential, fast-growing, cable assembly and box build company.

This position will carry out comprehensive quality assurance and inspection processes for NEP Electronics various product lines. You will be responsible for performing incoming, in-process and final inspections for all NEP Electronics product lines. The position is a member of quality assurance staff and will report directly to the Quality Manager, with advisory reporting responsibilities to the Production Supervisors, Production Manager and Plant Manager.

Responsibilities

- Perform inspections of raw material, sub-assemblies and WIP for all NEP Electronics products and components at all stages of production.
- Skilled user of measuring tools and equipment, micrometer, caliper, height gauge, rulers, go-no gages.
- Work with other QA personnel to monitor and report Incoming/Inline/Final inspection results.
- Work closely with Production and QA to ensure all corrective containment activities are effective.
- Report inspection results and quality issues to the Quality Manager.
- Report all production rejects, nonconformities, and production generated scrap material to ensure conformance to NEP Electronics' processes.
- Work closely with QA and Engineering to ensure all critical product characteristics are understood.
- Capable of operating all QA Inspection equipment, tools, force gauges, and microscopes.
